Ballet Master Class

A Company dancer will teach a ballet class to the students. The dancers will take the students through the paces of a traditional ballet class while imparting his or her own personal expertise as a technical dancer. Repertoire Class

A Company dancer will teach choreography from the touring show to the students. The dancers will take the students through the paces of learning choreography, applying musicality, personality and precision to their role – thus learning about the trade of working as a dancer and telling a story with movement. This aspect really connects the students to the performance and gives them something more personal to relate to when they see the show.
